To train with consistency and dedication

To avoid speaking negatively of any member or the instructor and to discuss any
misunderstanding in a direct, courteous manner with the person involved

To show loyalty to the instructor and the dojo in the same sincere way you will expect to
receive loyalty from your future students

To fulfill duties and service to the dojo unselfishly and willingly
